Getting Started

Applying online for Criminal Defence Aid with the Public Defender's Office ("PDO")

<u>Step 1:</u>

You may access the online application form through the following means:

- a) https://go.gov.sg/applypdo;
- b) Scan the QR code below; or



c) From the PDO's website (<u>https://pdo.mlaw.gov.sg</u>)

<u>Step 2:</u>

You should see a landing page with the title "Criminal Defence Aid Application".

<u>Step 3:</u>

Click on 'Log in with Singpass'.



<u>Step 4:</u>

You will be redirected to the Singpass login page. Log in by scanning the QR code using your Singpass App on your mobile phone or by entering your Singpass ID and Password.
